Brethren,

Once again, our officers for the year have been installed and we are ready to begin our year in the Valley of Salem. We have bid a fond farewell to Stark Peterson as Most

Wise Master of Sutton Lodge of Perfection and John Maihos as Most Wise Master of Emmanuel Chapter of Rose Croix. Both have led their bodies with wisdom and grace and certainly deserve the thanks of our Valley for all that they have done. The reputation of the Valley of Salem continues to grow in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. We all wish the best for Brothers Mike Guiffre and Jonathon Palermo as they pick up the reins of leadership. They have tough acts to follow, but we are all with them. They can do it!

The Valley of Boston is having it's a one-day class on December 3rd and I have received word that we have a couple candidates who will take advantage of it by joining the Valley of Salem as courtesy candidates. However, our Valley will be conferring the Degrees in October (Perfection) and November (Princes) prior to that date, so please get them to come down to Salem and join with us before that date. It will give them the chance to know us better than could happen at the big crowd that usually gathers in Boston. Here's another wrinkle, Brethren. I was told that the Supreme Council has changed the Grand Constitutions so that the MINIMUM initiation fees that a Vallev can charge is \$80 for Lodge of Perfection and \$20 each for Princes of Jerusalem and Rose Croix. So, we have to at least comply. Princes and Rose Croix are already okay as their initiation fees are \$30 each, but Perfection will have to

increase substantially. The likely number is \$90. Which will bring the total for US to \$150. And I have reason to believe that Massachusetts Consistory has increased their initiation fee to \$74. If all this is true, the total to join all four bodies (and that is required) will be \$224. Still quite the bargain when you think of all that you are getting. The heavily subsidized meals along make it worthwhile. But please let your candidates know what is going on.

I am sure that you have noticed that the Supreme Council last year took over the responsibility of sending out the dues bills and collecting the dues for ALL of the Valleys in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction. As a result, our dues bills include our dues plus dues for all of the other Valleys you might belong to - in particular, the Consistory dues which go to Valley of Boston. They then break the receipts down and send to each Valley that which is theirs. It actually works pretty well. HOWEVER, there are some of you who use the computer to issue your dues check and you have not changed the mailing address for the check. So you are still sending them to me. Brethren, if you are using the computer to cut your checks, or if you are using your bank's free check paying feature for your account could you PLEASE check to make sure that you have changed the address to be the Supreme Council's PO Box? It will help the system to work better and it will reduce the work I have to do, and after all, isn't that what we all want?

I am really looking forward to the upcoming year. It shows tremendous promise. I cannot wait to see you all down in the Valley!

SCOTTISH RITE SCHOLARSHIPS

The Scottish Rite Commitment to Education

O ne of Freemasonry's fundamental principles is a belief in the importance of the educated mind. Freedom, understanding, and brotherhood are dependent upon our ability to reason effectively. That is why the Masonic Fraternity, and the Scottish Rite in particular, have long been committed to fostering the value of education.

At a time when the cost of higher education is increasing, the Scottish Rite wants to assist qualified and deserving students in attaining their educational and career goals through its scholarship program.

As part of Supreme Council Charities, the Education and Charity Fund Scholarship Program has now been expanded. It is anticipated that many more scholarships will be awarded each year to eligible and deserving students attending colleges and universities of their choice and studying subjects of their choice.

The Abbott Scottish Rite Scholarship Program is supported by gifts from members and friends of Scottish Rite Masons to the annual Blue Envelope Appeal.

Eligibility Requirements

T hose meeting ONE the following criteria are eligible to apply for a scholarship:

• A Scottish Rite Mason of the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction;

or

• A student directly related (bloodline or by legal means) to a Scottish Rite Mason in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction; or

• A member of a youth organization sponsored by the Masonic fraternity in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction.

Additionally, the qualifying student must be ONE of the following:

• A high school senior, currently accepted at an accredited college, university, or trade school who has attained a minimum grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale;

or

• An undergraduate or graduate student currently enrolled at an accredited college or university.

Application forms are only available through the Supreme Council on-line website: www. scottishritenmj.org. Completed applications must be returned to the Valley Secretary in duplicate. Applications must be in the hands of the Valley Secretary (not postmarked) by April 1.

The Amount of Scholarship Aid

B oth the number of scholarships granted each year and the actual amount of individual scholarships are dependent upon funds available. It is hoped, however, that individual grants will range from \$500 to \$1,000. The number in any state will be modest inasmuch as fifteen states and over 100 Valleys are concerned.

> Supplemental Guide to Scottish Rite Scholarships Massachusetts Council of Deliberation

The following additional eligibility requirements are provided for guidance in applying for scholarship assistance in Massachusetts:

- Applicant must be enrolled as an undergraduate student, graduate school or vocational college student.
- Scholarship recipients may reapply annually for additional undergraduate assistance in competition with all other annual applicants.
- The applicant and the relative of the applicant who must be a Scottish Rite Mason from the Valley of Salem, may reside outside the state.
- A transcript of record must be submitted with application along with a copy of SAT/Entrance Exam scores.
- A copy of parent's/guardian's most recent year federal tax return that includes gross family income (Form 1040 front section) must be included.
- Suggestions: Do not be limited by space. Give supporting data on family conditions – siblings in college – selfhelp – extra-curricular, church, and community activities, etc.

Applications must be submitted to the Valley Secretary (at his home address) where his/ her relative holds his Lodge of Perfection, 14°, membership. The Valley Secretary will forward to the state Committee. Incomplete applications will not be considered, so please double check to insure that all required information is included. Members of Masonic youth organizations should apply through the Valley in which they reside.
