Summer has tarried late in our native New England. I find myself still in the placidity of sun and sweat despite September's arrival in a few days as I write these words. A blessed few more moments to allow thoughts to drift with the soft breezes, to look back at where we have come, and to reflect quietly on differences between what we believed past actions would yield and the reality which resulted.

Recent history has been turbulent: terrorist attacks in Barcelona and London, armed racists marching in Charlottesville and confronted by armed objectors from the left, North Korean threats of nuclear attack, incessant conflict between our current administration and the press and between the left and the right. We might ask, what can Masonic principles bring to this discord?

It was in this context that I have chosen to present the new 9th Degree, Master of the Temple, a degree that we have not performed before. Its message is one of universal brotherhood. Solomon the Wise welcomes six foreign priests to witness the dedication of the Temple. Each is invited to characterize the nature and character of the religion of his country. They all appear quite different and conflicting. Yet Solomon teases out the universal truth that underpins all of them and thus brings harmony through his dialectic with them. If nothing more, it is also an example to us that, as Moshe Dayan admonished, "If you want to make peace, you don't talk to your friends. You talk to your enemies."

I think that the message of this degree can thus serve as a profound point of departure for addressing the discordant diatribes of our day, and hope that you all will enjoy it as much as we are looking forward to presenting it to you. Beforehand, the Sutton Lodge of Perfection has the honour this year to receive our Deputy and I hope that as many of you as possible will come to welcome him. In addition to a powerful degree, you will also be rewarded by a sumptuous festive board following the performance as well as the opportunity to renew the bonds of fellowship following the summer's break.

I look forward to welcoming you all back at that time.
