SUTTON LODGE OF PERFECTION

Richard L Wise, 32° Thrice Potent Master

The tragedy of life is what dies inside a man while he lives.

Albert Schweitzer, philosopher, physician, and musician (1875-1965)

By the time you read these words, the cast members appearing in October 5th's 10th Degree, Master Elect, will already have been deep into our rehearsals. To my mind it is the most powerful and dramatic of the degrees offered by the Lodge of Perfection, one that is in essence a prose character of Solomon at his prime and of the aged Solomon as he greets death.

A tragedy presented in three scenes, the degree opens with some mocking of the foibles that have led Solomon astray and of his loyal counsellors' difficult decision to confront Solomon, and to urge him to mend his ways and beg the Almighty for forgiveness. The second scene begins with that confrontation and Solomon's harsh response at being chastened. Asking for solitude, he admits to himself the unbridled lust that has led him to violate the Almighty's first commandment but, believing himself to be entitled to an exception, endeavors to think about how he can convince his counsellors to agree with his action. To the contrary, everybody, soon or late, sits down to a banquet of consequences. No man, not even a king, is above the moral law and heaven having heard Solomon's musings,

responds with a punishment almost more than Solomon can bear. The scene ends with Solomon raging like King Lear at the decisiveness of his punishment.

The philosopher Schopenhauer wrote that "The closing years of life are like the end of a masquerade party, when the masks are dropped." Such is the final scene of this degree. Weak and frail and beaten by years of suffering, Solomon accepts his fate and admits his transgressions. While too late to make amends with the Lord, he seeks to do so with his loyal counsellors and guards, honoring them with an important closing ceremony until grasped by eternity's hand.

We shall be presenting the degree in an unusual setting. Rather than the degree being acted out in traditional biblical costumes and scenery, we bring it into the late 19th century of what could be Bismarck's or Tsar Alexander III's court chambers. I think you will all find that this lends a level of power and relevance to the allegory that you will not soon forget, and thus hope that all will mark their calendars and invite Brethren from other valleys, to witness what may well be the best degree performed in a long time. As is out custom, the degree will be followed by a cocktail hour with passed hors d'oeuvres and a festive board.

I look forward to welcoming you all back from our summer break and reconnecting with you all at that time.
